

RESOLUTION NO. RE17-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL THE VACANCIES OF THE MAYOR AND TWO COMMISSIONERS FOR THE NEWLY INCORPORATED TOWN OF BROCK, TEXAS TO BE HELD ON MAY 6, 2017, ESTABLISHING THE DATES AND TIMES OF EARLY VOTING FOR SUCH ELECTION; AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE PARKER COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE TO SERVE AS ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR, ADMINISTER THE ELECTION AND TO FURNISH ELECTION SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the town of Brock was incorporated by election held on November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, currently there exists a vacancy in the offices of the Mayor and two Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Government Code Chapter 24, when more than once vacancy exists, the County Judge shall call an election to fill said vacancies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS:

**Section 1. Recitals true and correct.** That the above findings are true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

**Section 2. Election Ordered.**

(a) That an election shall be held for the Town of Brock, Texas on May 6, 2017 to elect persons to fill the offices of Mayor and two Commissioners to serve until the next regular election when their successors are duly elected and qualified.

(b) That should a runoff be necessary it shall be held in compliance with the Texas Elections Code.

(c) That the County Judge shall execute the attached Order calling the election and establishing the time line for securing an application to be on the ballot, establishing the dates, times and polling places for said election.

(d) That the election shall be administered by the Parker County Elections Office. The Elections Administrator shall serve as the early voting clerk. The Elections Administrator shall as oversee the appointment of all judges, voting clerks, alternates and other officials and establish reasonable fees as set forth in the election services contract.

**Section 3. Eligible Voters.** All residents residing in the newly incorporated town of Brock who were eligible to vote in the incorporation election and who still reside in the area on Election Day as well as any newly authorized residents who meet state election voting requirements are eligible to vote.

**Section 4. Election Day Polling Place and Election Hours.** The date, polling places and hours are hereby designated as follows: **Saturday MAY 6, 2017 7:00-7:00 PM**
