## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-11-17.1

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF BROCK TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 7, 2017 SALES TAX ELECTION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the Commission of the Town of Brock duly authorized a Special Election to be held within the city limits on November 7, 2017 for the purpose of submitting to the resident qualified electors of the city the proposition hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has investigated all matters pertaining to said Election; and

WHEREAS, the Election officers who held said Election have duly made the return of the results thereof and said returns have been duly delivered to this Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission finds and declares that the meeting at which this Resolution is considered is open to the public as required by law, and that the public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given as required by Vernon's Ann. Texas Government Code, Section 551.041, as amended;

## NOW, THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF BROCK, TEXAS,

**SECTION 1.** The Commission finds that the statements set forth in the recitals of this Resolution are true and correct, and are incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** It is officially found and determined that said Election was duly ordered, that proper notice thereof was duly given, that proper Election officers were duly appointed prior to said Election, that said Election was duly and lawfully held, that due returns of the result of said Election have been made and delivered, and that this Commission has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling said Election.

**SECTION 3**. It is officially found and determined that the following votes were cast at said Election on the submitted proposition by the resident qualified electors of the Town who voted at said Election:

## **Proposition A**

Election for or against: A sales and use tax is adopted within the city at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%)

FOR	48	75%
AGAINST	16	25%

**SECTION 4**. As a result of said Election and in conformity with law, this Commission is authorized to implement a sales tax for general purposes on behalf of the Town in the manner and extent authorized by the Election and applicable law.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the Commission.
